

A Guide To Decide: What To Consider In Selecting Who You Vote For In 2020

Here's a nonpartisan framework for selecting the candidates you'll vote for in the 2020 elections, from the President to local offices and everything in between.

1. **SELECT LEADERSHIP QUALITIES:** For each of the 9 items below, select whichever of the two alternatives you believe best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years.
2. **REVIEW YOUR QUALITIES LIST:** Review the complete package of leadership qualities you selected.
3. **CHOOSE:** Decide which candidate for a particular office embodies your leadership qualities list more than the other candidate(s). If you aren't sure, here's a backup plan:
a) With each leadership quality you selected, identify which candidate you believe most embodies that specific quality. b) Add up how many qualities you assigned to each candidate, so you have a total score for each candidate. c) Vote for the one with the highest total score.

1) **Leading By Coercion or By Collaboration.** (Coercion is manipulating others to give in to us. Collaboration is working together toward a shared result.)

- Leadership by coercion best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
- Leadership by collaboration best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years

2) **Stoking Positions Wars or Combining Intentions Beneath Positions.** (Positions are opinions or solutions that we want others to agree with. Intentions are what is underneath positions — they are the concerns we are trying to resolve and goals we are trying to achieve.)

- Leadership that stokes positions wars best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
- Leadership that combines intentions of all concerned best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years

3) **Restoring Unity or Magnifying Divisiveness.** (This item should need no explanation.)

- Leadership that catalyzes unity best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
- Leadership that magnifies divisiveness and polarization best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years

4) Devotion to Deception or Accuracy. (Deception manipulates truth to promote an agenda. Accuracy discloses truth to promote clarity.)

- Leadership that uses deception to promote an agenda best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
- Leadership that promotes clarity by disclosing the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years

5) Focusing on Exposing Corruption and Restoring Power to the People or on Keeping the Corrupt in Power. (This item should need no explanation.)

- Leadership that feeds corruption and keeps the cabal in power best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
- Leadership that helps expose corruption and defeats the cabal best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years

6) Saying or Doing Things That Magnify Love or Magnify Fear/Hate. (This item should need no explanation.)

- Leadership that magnifies fear and hate best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
- Leadership that magnifies love best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years

7) Basing Choices on an "Ends Justifies the Means" Philosophy or on Spiritually Ethical Guiding Principles. (This item should need no explanation.)

- Leadership that selects strategies and tactics based on believing that the ends justify the means best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
- Leadership that selects strategies and tactics based on spiritually ethical guiding principles uses best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years

8) Making Fellow Americans the Enemy or Working Toward Shared Goals. (This item should need no explanation.)

- Leadership that casts groups of Americans as enemies best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
- Leadership that identifies and works toward goals that Americans share best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years

9) High or Low Levels of Collateral Damage. (Collateral damage is harm that is created while implementing a plan to reach a desired goal.)

- Leadership that is willing to pursue goals at the cost of high levels of collateral damage best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
- Leadership that is committed to keeping collateral damage low while pursuing goals best serves the highest interests of the United States over the next 4 years
